Back Country Outfitters in Corolla Light Town Center

From Kitty Hawk: Travel North on Highway 158. At the intersection with Hwy 12, turn right and continue 20 miles north through the village of Duck and into Corolla until you reach the Corolla Light Town Center - The shopping center is located 3 miles north of Food Lion, just south of the Currituck Lighthouse, on the ocean side of road. Back Country Outfitters is at 1210 Ocean Trail in the Corolla Light Town Center. Time: 45 min.

From Manteo: Travel east on Highway 64. Go left at the light towards Nags Head staying on 64 East. Travel approximately 3 miles across the Manteo/Nags Head Causeway. Bear left (north) on Hwy. 158 and continue north for 16 miles. At the intersection with Hwy 12, turn right and continue north through the village of Duck and into Corolla until you reach the Corolla Light Town Center - The shopping center is located 3 miles north of Food Lion, just south of the Currituck Lighthouse, on the ocean side of road. Back Country Outfitters is at 1210 Ocean Trail in the Corolla Light Town Center. Time: 1 hr. 20 min

From Buxton: Travel north on Highway 12 to Whalebone Junction. Go straight through the light and merge onto Hwy 158. Go north 16 miles. At the intersection with Hwy 12, turn right and continue north through the village of Duck and into Corolla until you reach the Corolla Light Town Center - The shopping center is located 3 miles north of Food Lion, just south of the Currituck Lighthouse, on the ocean side of road. Back Country Outfitters is at 1210 Ocean Trail in the Corolla Light Town Center. Time: 2 hrs. 15 min.

From Kitty Hawk: Travel south on Highway 158 through Kill Devil Hills and Nags Head. Take a left at the Whalebone Junction traffic light onto Hwy 12 South into Cape Hatteras National Seashore. Bodie Island Lighthouse is approximately 5 miles south on the right at Mile Post 22.5. Time: 30 min.

From Manteo: Travel east on Highway 64. Go left at the light towards Nags Head staying on 64 East Go approximately 3 miles on Highway 64 across the Manteo/Nags Head Causeway. Turn right on Highway 12 South into Cape Hatteras National Seashore. Bodie Island Lighthouse is approximately 5 miles south on the right at Mile Post 22.5. Time: 20 min.

From Buxton: Follow Highway 12 North across the Herbert C. Bonner Bridge (Oregon Inlet). Bodie Island Lighthouse is approximately 2 miles north on the left at Mile Post 22.5. Time: 50 min.

From Kitty Hawk: Travel south on Highway 158 through Kill Devil Hills and Nags Head. Bear right at the Whalebone Junction traffic light and merge onto Hwy 64 West. Travel west on Highway 64 bypass. Approximately 8 miles past Manns Harbor (3 miles past Creef Cut Parking Lot) turn left on Buffalo City Road. Drive to the end of the road (about 2 miles). Time: 50 min.

From Manteo: Travel west on Highway 64. Approximately 8 miles past Manns Harbor (3 miles past Creef Cut Parking Lot) turn left on Buffalo City Road. Drive to the end of the road (about 2 miles). Time: 25 min.

From Buxton: Travel north on Highway 12 to the Whalebone Junction traffic light. Turn left onto Highway 64 West. Travel west on Highway 64 bypass. Approximately 8 miles past Manns Harbor (3 miles past Creef Cut Parking Lot) turn left on Buffalo City Road. Drive to the end of the road (about 2 miles). Time: 1 hr. 35 min.

Cape Hatteras Lighthouse Visitor Parking Area / Hatteras Island Visitor Center Pavilion

From Kitty Hawk: Travel south on Highway 158 through Kill Devil Hills and Nags Head. Take a left at the Whalebone Junction traffic light onto Hwy 12 South into Cape Hatteras National Seashore. Go over the Herbert C. Bonner Bridge (Oregon Inlet) to Pea Island National Wildlife Refuge. Continue south on Highway 12 into the village of Buxton. Watch for Comfort Inn on your left at Mile Post 61.5; the road beside it is called Old Lighthouse Road. CONTINUE PAST OLD LIGHTHOUSE ROAD! The next road to the left will be the entrance to the Lighthouse. Follow signs to the lighthouse. Time: 1 hr. 30 min.

From Manteo: Travel east on Highway 64. Go left at the light towards Nags Head (staying on 64 East). Go approximately 3 miles on Highway 64 across the Manteo/Nags Head Causeway. Turn right on Highway 12 South into Cape Hatteras National Seashore. Go over the Herbert C. Bonner Bridge (Oregon Inlet) to Pea Island National Wildlife Refuge. Continue south on Highway 12 into the village of Buxton. Watch for Comfort Inn on your left at Mile Post 61.5; the road beside it is called Old Lighthouse Road. CONTINUE PAST OLD LIGHTHOUSE ROAD! The next road to the left will be the entrance to the Lighthouse. Follow signs to the lighthouse. Time: 1 hr.

From Buxton: (Points south of Buxton): Travel north on Highway 12. Watch for the Little League Baseball/Softball field approximately 2 miles from the school at Mile Post 61.5. Take the next right and follow signs to the lighthouse. Time: 5 min.

From Kitty Hawk: Travel south on Highway 158 through Kill Devil Hills and Nags Head. Take a left at the Whalebone Junction traffic light onto Hwy 12 South into Cape Hatteras National Seashore. Go over the Herbert C. Bonner Bridge (Oregon Inlet) to Pea Island National Wildlife Refuge. Continue south on Highway 12 into the village of Buxton. The school is on the right at Mile Post 63 approximately 2 miles past the turn-off for the Cape Hatteras Lighthouse on Highway 12. Time: 1 hr. 30 min.

From Manteo: Travel east on Highway 64. Go left at the light towards Nags Head (staying on 64 East). Go approximately 3 miles on Highway 64 across the Manteo/Nags Head Causeway. Turn right on Highway 12 South into Cape Hatteras National Seashore. Go over the Herbert C. Bonner Bridge (Oregon Inlet) to Pea Island National Wildlife Refuge. Continue south on Highway 12 into the village of Buxton. The school is on the right at Mile Post 63 approximately 2 miles past the turn-off for the Cape Hatteras Lighthouse on Highway 12. Time: 1 hr.

From Buxton: The Cape Hatteras School is on the right at Mile Post 63 approximately 2 miles south of the turn-off for the Cape Hatteras Lighthouse on Highway 12. Time: 10 min.

From Kitty Hawk: Travel south on Highway 158 through Kill Devil Hills and Nags Head. Take a left at the Whalebone Junction traffic light onto Hwy 12 South into Cape Hatteras National Seashore. Go over the Herbert C. Bonner Bridge (Oregon Inlet) to Pea Island National Wildlife Refuge. Continue south on Highway 12 through the refuge to the town of Rodanthe (first town past the refuge). Just under 1 mile into town, once you have passed the liberty gas station on your right look for the Chicamacomico Life-Saving Station sign on your left. Time: 50 min.

From Manteo: Travel east on Highway 64. Go left at the light towards Nags Head (staying on 64 East). Go approximately 3 miles on Highway 64 across the Manteo/Nags Head Causeway. Turn right on Highway 12 South into Cape Hatteras National Seashore. Go over the Herbert C. Bonner Bridge (Oregon Inlet) to Pea Island National Wildlife Refuge. Continue south on Highway 12 through the refuge to the town of Rodanthe (first town past the refuge). Just under 1 mile into town, once you have passed the liberty gas station on your right look for the Chicamacomico Life-Saving Station sign on your left. Time: 40 min.

From Buxton: Travel north on Highway 12. Go through the town of Avon and into the town of Rodanthe. Look for the Chicamacomico Life-Saving Station sign on your right just past the Joseph Mac Midgett Water Plant sign – If you reach the Liberty Station you have gone too far. Time: 30 min.

From Kitty Hawk: Travel North on Highway 158. At the intersection with Hwy 12, turn right and continue north through the villages of Duck and Corolla. After you pass Currituck Heritage Park, turn left after the Currituck Beach Lighthouse where you will find Historic Corolla Village. The boardwalk and shop site are across the street from the restored Corolla Schoolhouse. Time: 45 min.

From Manteo: Travel east on Highway 64. Go left at the light towards Nags Head staying on 64 East. Go approximately 3 miles on Highway 64 across the Manteo/Nags Head Causeway. Bear left (north) on Highway 158 and continue north for 16 miles. Around Mile Post 1 turn right on to NC 12 and continue north through the towns of Duck and Corolla. After you pass Currituck Heritage Park, turn left after the Currituck Beach Lighthouse where you will find Historic Corolla Village. From Manteo: Travel east on Highway 64. Go left at the light towards Nags Head staying on 64 East. Go approximately 3 miles on Highway 64 across the Manteo/Nags Head Causeway. Bear left (north) on Highway 158 and continue north for 16 miles. Around Mile Post 1 turn right on to NC 12 and continue north through the towns of Duck and Corolla. The Whalehead Club is located within the Currituck Heritage Park on the left just north of Corolla. Time: 1 hr. 20 min.

It is the little blue building located just before the last set of lights heading off of the Outer Banks. If you get to the last stop light before the Wright Memorial Bridge you have passed it. The address is 6150 North Croatan Hwy. Time: 15 min.
